

**ONDOKUZ MAYIS UNIVERSITY
CRITERIA TO PASS THE ENGLISH PREPARATORY COURSE**

EXEMPTION FROM THE ENGLISH PREPARATORY COURSE:

The exemption exam is held at the beginning of Fall and Spring semesters for exemption from the English Preparatory Course. Successful students are given a “certificate of achievement” indicating the foreign language level in line with the EU Common Language Framework Program. Students in the compulsory preparatory class, who are successful in the spring semester proficiency exam, can take courses from the department / program they are enrolled in or they can be considered to be on leave in the spring semester.

The students, who score at least 60 points out of 100 in the proficiency exam, are considered as successful and start their education in the programs they have enrolled. The compulsory preparatory course students, who get less than 60, can continue their preparatory education or improve their foreign language skills by their own means and take the foreign language proficiency test in the following semester.

OPTIONAL ENGLISH PREPARATORY COURSE:

Students, who want to take a one-year English Language Preparatory education, can attend within the quota. The duration of the preparatory program is not included in the years shown in the academic curriculum.

GERMAN PREPARATORY COURSE:

One-year German Preparatory Program is applied. The preparatory class is not included in the years shown in the academic curriculum. Those who pass the German proficiency exam, are directly admitted to the first year. “Regulation on Foreign Language Teaching in Higher Education Institutions and the Principles to be Followed in Teaching Foreign Language” provisions are applied to the students.

FRENCH PREPARATORY COURSE:

One-year French Preparatory Program is applied. The preparatory class is not included in the years shown in the academic curriculum. Those who pass the French proficiency exam are directly admitted to the first year. “Regulation on Foreign Language Teaching in Higher Education Institutions and the Principles to be Followed in Teaching Foreign Language” provisions are applied to the students.

ARABIC PREPARATORY COURSE:

One-year Arabic Preparatory Program is applied. The preparatory class is not included in the years shown in the teaching time column. Those who pass the Arabic proficiency exam are

directly admitted to the first year. "Regulation on Foreign Language Teaching in Higher Education Institutions and the Principles to be Followed in Teaching Foreign Language" provisions are applied to the students.
