CRITERIA TO PASS THE ENGLISH OR ANOTHER FOREIGN LANGUAGE COURSE

1) Criteria to Pass English or Another Foreign Language Course:

- a) A 1-year compulsory English Preparatory Program is applied. At the end of the program, the candidates who pass the English Proficiency Exam are directly enrolled in the first year.
- b) The English Preparatory Program is not included in the years shown in the teaching time column.
- c) The candidates, who certify that in one of the national and / or international foreign language exams accepted by the university, are successful at the level determined by the university and who are successful in the English Proficiency Exam to be held at the beginning of the academic year, are directly taken into the first year.
- d) The student has to succeed by getting 70 points out of a minimum of 100 points in the proficiency exam.

Note: In addition to the above-mentioned general conditions, the candidates applying to the departments providing foreign language education should be successful in the foreign language exam to be conducted by the School of Foreign Languages of our university. From the exams that are considered equivalent to this exam and that are accepted by the School of Foreign Languages (UDS or KPDS) or that are accepted as equivalent by the inter-university board (TOEFL-IBT, TOEFL-CBT, TOEFL-IBT, IELTS, CAE, FCE, CPE) the candidates who have received enough points are considered successful from the Foreign Language Proficiency Exam.

2) The Optional English Preparatory Course

1-year English Language Preparatory Program is offered to the the students who want to attend. The duration of the Preparatory Program is not included in the years shown in the teaching time column.

3) The Arabic Preparatory Course

- a) The language of instruction in this program is at least 30% Arabic. 1 year of compulsory Arabic Preparatory Program is applied. The preparatory course is not included in the years shown in the teaching period column. The students, who pass the Arabic Proficiency Exam, are directly taken into the first year.
- b) In the exemption exam held at the beginning of the academic year, a success rate of 70 or higher is required.

4) The French Preparatory Course

a) In the programs in which language of instruction is at least 30% French, 1-year compulsory French Preparatory Program is applied. At the end of the program, the students who pass the French Proficiency Exam are enrolled directly in the first year. The French preparatory class is not included in the years shown in the teaching time column.

b) The students, who certify that they have been successful in one of the national and / or international foreign language exams in the level determined by the university and accepted by the university and the students who have been successful in the French Proficiency Exam that is made at the beginning of the academic year, are taken directly to the first year.
